

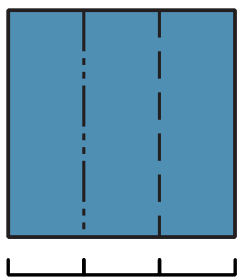
Slider N 5



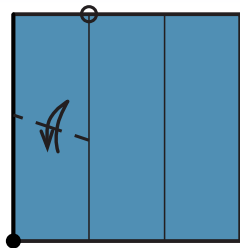
Use five 75 mm squares
or larger
Finished model ratio 1.4

It may seem surprising that an odd number of units can slide. However, holding two points and moving them makes another unit move, one that is not directly held. Notice how the unit achieves the 1:3 approximation of 18° .

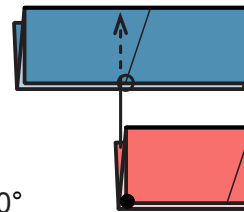
Module ★★



1 Pleat into thirds and unfold.



2 Crease the bottom left corner to one third along the top. Reform pleats.



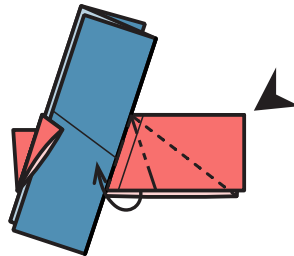
3 Make a second unit and put it in the first.



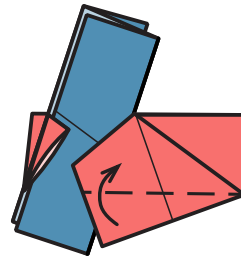
4 Fold the second unit along the crease of the first unit.



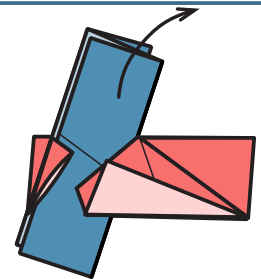
5 Remove the first unit. Put it under the folded flap.



6 Fold the top layer of the second unit against the first unit and squash.

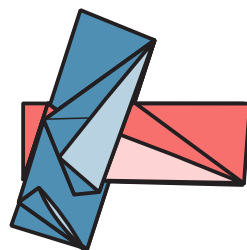
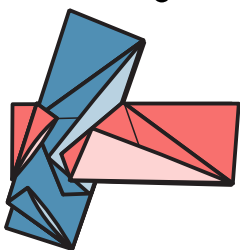


7 Fold up.



8 Remove the first unit.

Assembly ★★



1 Insert the first unit into the second.

2 Tuck the flaps of the first unit into the second.
